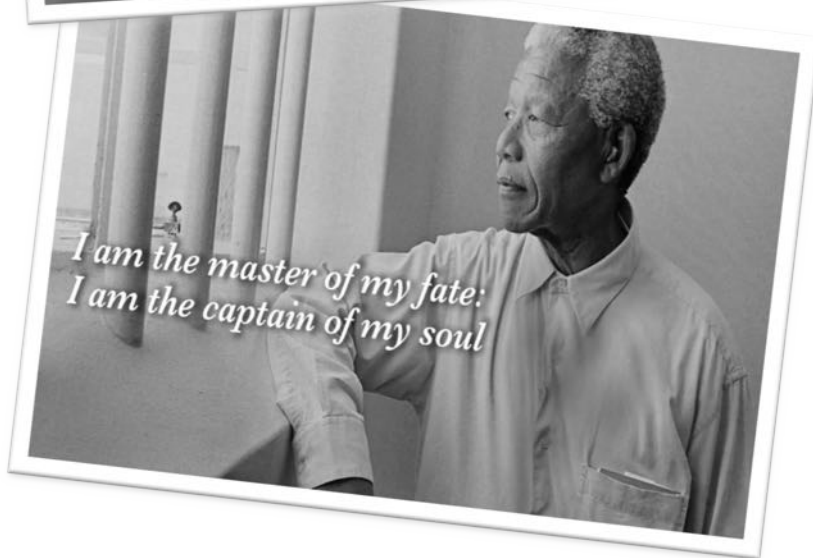
RECITALS
